- Meeting called to order at 5:39 pm by Tim Keith
- Meeting directed by Rena Lawrence and Tim Keith
- Minutes of meeting January 12, 2023 were unanimously approved
- Presentation of Treasurer's Report by Rena Lawrence
  - Beginning balance: \$ 12, 837.88 (FWCCU Checking)
    - Ending balance: \$9,645.37
  - Beginning balance: \$ 65,239.01 (FWCCU Savings)
    - Ending balance: \$65, 359.77
- Treasurers report was reviewed and unanimously approved
- New Business:
  - Officer election—proposed slate:
    - President—Tim Keith
    - Vice President—Jack Edmondson
    - Secretary—Lynn Geis
    - Treasurer—Cara Kennemer
  - Proposed slate was unanimously approved
- Old Business:
  - Status of collections inventory grant
    - Not granted; those funds will be available for other uses
  - Status of promotional video
    - Rena and Sheran are working on this and getting proposals together
- Village news and updates
  - Village statistics—visitors from 39 states and 33 countries (October 2022 – present)
  - Spring break was not our best this year partly due to inclement weather
  - The months of February and March were still good
  - The April/ May issue of Fort Worth Child Magazine has an ad on Log Cabin Village and the June/ July issue Log Cabin Village will have another ad as well
  - Facebook Ads have been completed
  - LCHF members suggest looking for someone to write an article on Log Cabin Village
  - The Wagon West Program is doing well
  - Booked tour groups have continued to be successful
  - April 22 — Tasting the Past class

- Only two spots are still available
  - Exploring the history of vegetarianism
- Fort Worth Museum of Science and History
  - We are partnering with the museum to record monthly podcasts called *Histometer* for every building on site
  - The first podcast will be available in late April as a general episode; each later podcast will feature a specific cabin
  - The podcasts are twenty minutes in length
- The Stopping Stones installation ceremony will be held Saturday June 10<sup>th</sup> starting at 9AM
  - Please refer to the itinerary found on the Log Cabin Village website for a detailed schedule and more information
  - The Log Cabin Village is the first place in Texas to have the Stopping Stones
  - Sheran will sing while the Stones are being installed
  - Each stone costs \$250 and we will be installing two for the Foster Cabin

- The wickiup was destroyed in the ice storm
